THE POWER OF GOD'S WORD TO SHOW YOU THE WAY TO HEAVEN

INTRODUCCIÓN:

- 1. An invitation to search the Scriptures:
 - a. Acts 17:11; 1 Thessalonians 5:21; 1 John 4:1; John 7:17
- 2. The Bible is God's Powerful Book (Hebrews 4:12; Jeremiah 23:29; Psalm 33:6).
 - a. The Bible has power to help us not to sin against God (Psalm 119:11).
 - b. The Bible has power to overcome temptation (Matthew 4:4, 7, 10).
 - c. The Bible has power to help us not be destroyed (Hosea 4:6).
 - d. God's Word will not return void (Isaiah 55:11).
- 3. The Bible also has power to save our souls (James 1:21; 1 Peter 2:2; 2 Timothy 3:15; Romans 1:16; John 8:51).
- 4. In this lesson we will examine the way the Scriptures show us the way to make it to heaven. This way is called, the plan of salvation.
- 5. Therefore, we will study what a person must do in order to spend eternity in heaven.

Let us examine what God's Word tells us regarding heaven and salvation:

I. GOD'S WORD TELLS US THAT THERE IS A HEAVEN PREPARED FOR THOSE WHO OBEY.

- A. Jesus, the Son of God went to prepare a place for us (John 13:1-3).
- B. The citizenship for those who are in Christ is in heaven (Philippians 3:20).
- C. We have a house not made with hands in the heavens (2 Corinthians 5:1-2).
- D. God wants to have you in heaven (1 Timothy 2:4; 2 Peter 3:9; John 3:16).
- E. Therefore, there is no doubt that heaven is a real place prepared for the faithful.

II. GOD'S WORD SHOWS US THE SURE WAY TO HEAVEN.

- A. God's inspired Word teaches us that Jesus is the way to heaven:
 - a. He is the way, the truth and the life (John 14:6).
 - b. He is the door to salvation (John 10:9). Satan has created many doors!
 - c. He is the only way to salvation (Acts 4:12).
 - d. Eternal life is only in Christ (2 Timothy 2:10; 1 John 5:11; John 11:25-26).
 - e. He is the only solution to the sin problem (John 1:29; Ephesians 1:7).
- B. Men must understand that without Jesus, he cannot enter heaven.

III. THERE IS A PLAN TO ENTER HEAVEN

- A. This plan is called, "The Plan of Salvation".
- B. Let us turn to Acts 2 to learn how this plan of salvation involves the following conditions:
 - a. The plan of salvation to enter heaven involves hearing the gospel of Christ (Mark 16:15; Romans 1:16; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4; ACTS 2:22-36).

- b. The plan of salvation to enter heaven involves people believing in the gospel of Christ (Mark 16:16; ACTS 2:37).
- c. The plan of salvation to enter heaven involves people repenting of their sins (Acts 17:11; 2 Peter 3:9; ACTS 2:38; 3:19).
- d. The plan of salvation to enter heaven involves being baptized for the remission of your sins (ACTS 2:38, 41; 22:16; Mark 16:16; 1 Peter 3:21).
- e. The plan of salvation to enter heaven involves being added to the church of Jesus Christ (Matthew 16:18; ACTS 2:47; Ephesians 1:22-23).
- f. The plan of salvation to enter heaven involves living a faithful life in Christ (Revelation 2:10; ACTS 2:42).
- C. Any person who desires to enter heaven must do exactly what those on Pentecost did. Do you want to spend eternity in heaven?

CONCLUSION:

- 1. There is no way on earth that you and I can learn about heaven without turning to the powerful Scriptures of God.
- 2. This is why we would like to encourage everyone to be diligent students of the Word!
