"HAVE YOU BEEN WITH JESUS?"

TEXT: Acts 4:1-31 OBJECTIVES:

- 1. To inform Christians what is needed of us for people in the world to realize that we have been influenced by Jesus Christ.
- 2. To encourage Christians to follow the example of Jesus and the Apostles so that by doing so, we can be a positive example to the world.

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. What a wonderful opportunity the Apostles had to spend time with Jesus and to learn from Him (just think about it!).
- 2. The positive influence Jesus had upon the lives of the Apostles was so great that they were even willing to die for Him!
 - a. Peter and the Apostles were willing to die for Jesus (Matthew 26:35).
 - b. Paul was an imitator of Jesus (1 Corinthians 11:1).
- 3. Anyone who saw the Apostles and the way they lived their lives knew that they had been influenced by Jesus Christ.
- 4. Carefully think about this:
 - a. Do your friends at work know that you are a Christian?
 - b. Do your friends in college know that you are a Christian?
 - c. Do your neighbors know that you are a Christian?
- 5. In this lesson I want to encourage the church to live our lives in such a way as to allow the world to see and realize that we have been with Jesus.
- 6. In this lesson I want to...
 - a. Look at the remote context of our text under consideration
 - b. Show the things we need in our lives to let people know we have been with Jesus
 - c. Show the blessings of having been influenced by Jesus
- 7. As we listen to this lesson, please allow the words of such to sink into your ears (Luke 9:44). May we also plan to practice the things we learn from God's Word (James 1:22-25).

THE REMOTE CONTEXT OF ACTS 4.

- 1. Peter and John healed a man who was lamed in chapter 3 (Jerusalem).
 - a. As a result of this miracle, the priests, the captain of the temple, and the Sadducees came upon the Apostles (4:1).
- 2. This is approximately the year 33 AD.
- 3. The church of Christ has been already established and continues to grow numerically (Acts 4:4).
- 4. The Apostles Peter and John are preaching the gospel of Christ in Jerusalem just like Jesus commanded them to do (Acts 1:8).
- 5. The church begins to experience difficulties by those who do not want the message of Jesus to be preached to people (Acts 4:1-3, 18).

THINGS CHRISTIANS NEED IN THEIR LIVES TO SHOW THE WORLD THEY HAVE BEEN WITH JESUS.

- 1. #1: We need to be disciples of Jesus:
 - a. Peter and John were disciples of Jesus!

- b. The Greek word for "disciple" is $\mu\alpha\theta\eta\tau\dot{\eta}\varsigma$ which means: One who engages in learning through instruction from another; a follower of someone (BDAG).
- c. Who is a disciple of Jesus?
- d. A disciple is one who keeps the Word of Christ (John 8:31).
 - i. To keep the Word means to believe the Word, and to continually practice what the Word teaches (James 1:22-25; Luke 11:28).
- e. A disciple is one who loves his brethren (John 13:34-35).
- f. A disciple is one who bears much fruit constantly abiding in Christ (John 15:8).

2. Jesus was a disciple of God:

- a. He obeyed God (John 4:34; 6:38).
- b. He preached what God told Him to preach (John 12:49-50). This is what a disciple does!
- c. He worked as His Father did (John 5:17).
- d. He imitated His Father (John 5:19).
- e. He did the Father's will (John 5:30).
- f. This is what a disciple does!
- g. These things must be practiced by all Christians if we want the world to know that we have been with Jesus!

3. #2: We need to possess "boldness" in our Christian life:

- a. The word "boldness" comes from the Greek word **παρρησία** which means a state of confidence and courage; to be frank and outspoken; to be free from fear (BDAG).
- b. Peter and John were filled with boldness as they preached the Gospel of Christ!
- c. We need to pray for boldness if we don't have it (Acts 4:29, 31).
- d. Boldness is a must if we want to be successful at preaching the Gospel! (Romans 1:14-16; 1 Corinthians 9:16).
- e. Peter and John and the rest of the Apostles possessed boldness in their lives.
- f. Jesus Christ possessed boldness in his life! This is why He was able to do all the things He did!
- 4. These two things are needed in order to let the world know that we have been with Jesus!

7 BLESSINGS OF BEING A TRUE DISCIPLE OF JESUS WHO POSSESSES BOLDNESS AS A RESULT OF HAVING BEEN WITH JESUS.

- 1. We will preach the resurrection from the dead with boldness (Acts 4:2).
- 2. Nothing will stop us from serving Jesus Christ (Acts 4:19-20; Acts 5:29).
- 3. Many will believe in the message of salvation (Acts 4:4).
- 4. The church will grow strong spiritually and numerically (Acts 4:4).
- 5. We will not be afraid to tell the world that Jesus is the only way to salvation (Acts 4:12; John 10:9; 14:6).
- 6. People will know we have been with Jesus! (Acts 4:13).
- 7. People will glorify God (Acts 4:21; Matthew 5:16).

CONCLUSIÓN:

- 1. In this lesson we have examined those things needed to let the world know that we have been influenced by Jesus.
- 2. May God grant us the wisdom and the courage to live our lives like Jesus, Peter, John, and the rest of the Apostles did!
