"HOW DO I KNOW I AM SAVED?"

TEXT: 1 John 5:13

PURPOSE:

- 1. To encourage Christians to realize that we can be sure about our eternal salvation in Christ.
- 2. To encourage Christians to take care of their salvation.
- 3. To encourage non-Christians to obey the Gospel of Christ.

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Are you 100% sure that you have the hope of eternal life, which God, who cannot lie, promised before times eternal? (Titus 1:2).
- 2. How do you know that if you die today you will go to heaven someday?
- 3. There are some in the Lord's church that are not 100% sure about their eternal salvation!
 - a. Some know for sure they will not make it to heaven because they are not living a faithful life in Christ.
 - b. Others are trying their best to faithfully serve God in His Kingdom, but do not know for sure whether they will make it to heaven.
 - c. Some say, "well, I cannot know for sure whether I will make it to heaven. Only God knows."
 - d. Others say, "I just cannot tell you for sure I will make it to heaven because in the end, only God will decide whether I'll be there or not."
- 4. These comments clearly show the presence of doubt in the minds of some today!
 - a. Satan is always attacking our minds! (1 Peter 5:8).
- 5. In this lesson we will discuss...
 - a. Ways on how we can know we are saved.
 - b. Ways on how we can stay saved.
 - c. An exhortation to those who have not obeyed the Gospel of Christ.
- 6. The topic under consideration is an important one because it deals with the eternal salvation of our souls.
 - a. Remember that this world will come to an end someday (2 Peter 3:10-12).
 - b. Remember that Jesus Christ will come when we least expect it (Matthew 24:44).
 - c. Remember that death may come to us at any moment (James 4:14; Hebrews 9:27).
- 7. For this reason, we all need to pay close attention to where we want to spend eternity!
- 8. As we listen to this lesson, please allow the words of such to sink into your ears (Luke 9:44). May we also plan to practice the things we learn from God's Word (James 1:22-25).

THE ASSURANCE OF THE HOPE OF OUR ETERNAL SALVATION.

- 1. How can we know we have the hope of eternal life? How can we know we are saved?
- 2. Ways to know we can be sure we have salvation in Christ:
 - a. **#1:** We need to understand that God's Word, the Bible, can be understood (Ephesians 3:4; John 8:32; John 7:17).
 - b. **#2:** God's Word not only can be understood but can also save us (2 Timothy 3:15; James 1:21; **Acts 13:26**, "The Word of this salvation"; **1 Corinthians 15:2**, "If we hold fast the Word, we are saved"!).
 - c. **#3:** God's Word reveals to us that God wants our salvation (John 3:16; Romans 5:8; Titus 2:11; 1 Timothy 2:4).
 - d. **#4:** God's Word also reveals to us that we have a Savior, Jesus Christ (Acts 4:12; John 10:9; 14:6; Matthew 20:28; **Gal. 1:4** "He can deliver us from this evil present age").

- **A.** He is the solution to our sin problem (John 1:29; Ephesians 1:7; Mark 2:10; 1 John 2:1-2).
- e. **#5:** God's inspired Word also cultivates within our hearts/minds that great truth that we can be sure about our hope of eternal salvation (1 John 5:13; Philippians 4:3).
- 3. In addition to these things, notice also how we can know we have the hope of eternal life:
 - a. **#1:** Those who have obeyed the Gospel of Christ are saved, for the Gospel is the power of God for salvation (Romans 1:16; 1 Corinthians 15:1-4).
 - b. **#2:** Those who have believed the message of the Gospel of Christ are saved, for belief in Jesus is essential to salvation (Mark 16:16; John 8:24; John 3:16).
 - c. **#3:** Those who have repented of their sins are saved, for repentance is essential to salvation (Luke 13:3, 5; Acts 3:19; 2 Peter 3:9).
 - d. **#4:** Those who confessed that Jesus Christ is the Son of God are saved, for confession is essential to salvation (Romans 10:9-10; Matthew 10:32-33).
 - e. **#5:** Those who have been baptized for the forgiveness of sins are saved, for baptism is for the purpose of obtaining salvation (Mark 16:16; 1 Peter 3:21; Acts 2:38; 22:16).
 - **A.** Those who have been baptized, have been baptized into Christ (Galatians 3:27; Romans 6:3-4; The hope of eternal life is located in Christ (1 John 5:11). That's exactly where we are!
- 4. Any person within the age of accountability who has obeyed the Gospel of Christ can know for sure he or she has the hope of eternal life.
- 5. Only those who have obeyed and continue to stay faithful can be sure of their eternal salvation (Acts 10; 11:14; 2 Timothy 2:10). We can be sure without a shadow of a doubt!
- 6. We thank God for His Word because through the Scriptures we can learn and know we have the hope of eternal life.

TAKING CARE OF OUR HOPE OF ETERNAL SALVATION.

- 1. There is no doubt in our minds that God has promised the hope of eternal life (Titus 1:2).
- 2. Nevertheless, this hope of eternal life, this salvation in Christ must be taken care of!
- 3. Our salvation can be lost if we do not take care of it:
 - a. Philippians 2:12 We take care of our salvation with fear and trembling!
 - b. 1 Corinthians 9:27 We can be disqualified from our salvation!
 - c. Revelation 2:10; James 1:12 We can lose our crown of life!
 - d. 2 Timothy 4:7-9 We can lose the crown of righteousness!
 - e. 1 Corinthians 5:2 We have salvation only if we hold fast to it!
 - f. Galatians 5:4 We can fall from grace!
- 4. Several Christians in the Bible lost their salvation
 - a. Demas (2 Timothy 4:10).
 - b. The false teachers in 2 Peter and Jude.
 - c. Christians in the Book of Hebrews.
 - d. Some in the context of 1 John (Gnostics; 1 John 2:19)
- 5. Ways on how we can avoid losing our salvation based on 1 John.
 - a. Do not depart from the faith (1 John 2:19).
 - b. Do not become a liar (1 John 1:8-9).
 - c. Do not deny that Jesus is the Christ (1 John 2:22).
 - d. Do not deny the incarnation of Christ (1 John 4:3).
 - e. Do not hate your brothers and sisters in Christ (1 John 3:15).
 - f. Grow in the knowledge of God's Word (1 John 2:14).
 - g. Do not love the world nor the things of the world (1 John 2:15-17).
- 6. This is the reason why we must live faithful lives in Christ!
- 7. Losing our eternal salvation will bring eternal consequences!

CONCLUSIÓN:

- 1. In this lesson we have examined two main points regarding how we can be sure of our eternal salvation, and how we can take care of it!
- 2. I would like to end this lesson by encouraging non-Christians to obey the Gospel of Christ before it is eternally too late.
- 3. May we always have the full assurance of our eternal salvation in Christ.
- 4. May we never doubt we have salvation in Christ!
